
From Fear to Confidence: Naomi's Journey

Back in September, we shared Naomi's story-a young woman facing an unplanned pregnancy. Today, we have a special update on her journey.

Naomi came to our Center last summer, feeling overwhelmed and alone. Nervous and withdrawn, she hid behind her sunglasses, reluctant to open up. I had the privilege of walking alongside Naomi that day, and as we talked, she cried as she shared about her two previous abortions, describing them as "traumatizing." She felt like she had no choices back then and didn't think she could go through it again.

She kept repeating, "I can't have a kid...I can barely take care of myself, let alone another human being." With no support from the baby's father and strained family relationships, she felt stuck.

We gently walked through all her options, including adoption, which she considered. During her ultrasound, she told the doctor to turn the monitor away so she wouldn't have to look at the images. The doctor told her she was 9 weeks pregnant. He attached pictures of her baby to the back of her paperwork, just in case she decided to look at them later. Afterward, we gave her space and time to process her emotions, reassuring her that she was not alone, and that support was available.



One day, during a particularly busy baby store day, I was called downstairs to help. I was surprised to see a very pregnant Naomi shopping for baby clothes! I hardly recognized her-gone was the fearful, withdrawn woman I had met months earlier. Instead, I saw a confident, joyful mom-to-be excitedly preparing for her baby boy's arrival. I hadn't seen Naomi since that initial meeting last summer, but I happily discovered she had taken some of our online parenting classes, and this was her first visit to our baby store.

The following week, Naomi let us know she gave birth to a healthy baby boy! He arrived earlier than expected, and we were able to provide her with some much-needed preemie clothing.

This "full circle" story is a beautiful reminder of how God works-turning fear into confidence, uncertainty into joy. We are grateful to have been part of Naomi's journey and to see her transformation. Thank you for making stories like Naomi's possible!

After disbursements, it is the goal of the Missions Committee to disburse the remaining funds to affiliated groups to help send other kids to Christian camp(s).
