Mark & Joy Sims

Joy lived in Little Meadows, PA and grew up in the SABC, where her parents, Glenn & Helen, served in a number of number of ministries over the years. It was their example and hospitality toward missionaries who stayed in their home that led Joy to first consider becoming a missionary.

Beginning at age 9, Mark began to have a Christian influence in his home that increased as he grew older.

Mark & Joy met at Word of Life Bible Institute, Schroon Lake, NY, and began dating at the end of the year. They attended a missionary conference and committed themselves to pursue missions if they felt the Lord's calling. In the following year, circumstances led them to believe that that was, indeed, the Lord's plan when the former theology prof at WOLBI encouraged them to consider serving as missionaries in France.

They graduated from Columbia Bible College and began to pursue ministry in France. They arrived on the field in 1988, and for the next 12 years evangelized and sought to plant churches.

Although they continued in evangelism throughout their career, Mark began teaching in Chad, Africa, which grew to be his main ministry eventually including the Central African Republic and Cameroon.

Joy continued in evangelism, particularly through hospitality and teaching quilting which, along with Mark's teaching in Africa and several countries in Europe continues even today.

After 33 years of service, they officially retired and moved to near Lynchburg, VA but continue to return to all these ministries. Mark teaches twice a year in Germany and Prague and once a year in Chad. Joy returns to France each year to continue her quilt camps with the many saved and unsaved French women with whom she remains in contact.

Matthew at Life Choices

Matthew is the Director of the Courageous Choices Men's Program at Life Choices Center in Binghamton. Matthew's journey began in Long Island, NY, where he grew up as the youngest of three in a middle-class family. His early years were marked by poor choices and destructive behaviors, leading to a period of incarceration. However, a personal encounter with God transformed his life, leading Matthew to embrace Jesus as his Savior and Lord, and to commit to a life of service.


Matthew discovered his God-given purpose while working in a substance abuse treatment program, where he quickly realized that he "serves God by serving people." His passion and dedication led him to a pivotal moment when Executive Director Michelle Brown and the Life Choices Center Board, guided by God's direction, launched a full-time men's program to support individuals through and beyond unplanned pregnancies. Matthew stepped into the role of Men's Program Director in January 2022, with the vision to "change the world, one man at a time."

Under Matthew's leadership, the Courageous Choices Men's Program has thrived, serving nearly 300 men, many of whom come from unchurched backgrounds and face significant worldly influences. Despite the challenges of rapid growth, the program has become a beacon of hope, fostering an environment of trust and vulnerability. The result of this supportive foundation is the ongoing development of relationships that enhance the lives of these men and their families.
