### From My Desk to Yours:

As much as things change, some things will never change. We were challenged at our yearly meeting with our Silent Word missionary team to take THIS (the Bible) to THEM (the Deaf/ Hearing who have never seen/heard the Gospel). While the ways we minister to people have changed over time, the message we share has not changed at all! Sitting here at my desk,

I have been thinking about how much things have changed, and how many things I have learned in the last few years about how to present it effectively. What seems like just a few years ago (but I am sure are more years ago than I would like to admit), we were talking about changing our materials over from VHS tapes to DVD discs. We were "cutting edge" at the time. We all experienced many changes during the COVID crisis. During that time, we realized that while we could not go out to hold meetings among the Deaf, the Deaf still needed the encouragement from the Word of God. We made a ministry decision to drastically increase our on-line efforts. We posted a Bible study, or something special every day for the Deaf during that time. Something amazing happened. The impact of our ministry increased during the COVID challenges! We met far more people because of this on-line presence than Specializing in Deaf Ministry we would have by driving thousands of miles across the country to hold meetings. There was something else that happened during that time. God opened a new door of opportunity for us that continues until this day.

We have a new ministry tract that has produced incredible results, as well as incredible opportunities. Terry and I now meet once a month with Deaf in the Philippines. We share precious fellowship and a time together in the Word of God! All this came about because of a world-wide pandemic! I am sitting here at my desk thanking God for His hand moving us through all kinds of challenges. God is always in control!

### **DEAF DISCIPLESHIP**


